

# PASSING SCHEME AND PROMOTIONAL RULES FOR POST-GRADUATE COURSES (M.A, M. Sc. and M.Com) UNDER SEMESTER SCHEME

---

1. The minimum marks required to pass any paper in a semester scheme is 40% in theory and 40% in practical, wherever applicable.
2. Student must secure 40% in the end of semester examination and 40% in the total of End semester examination & Internal Assessment of the paper for both theory & practical separately.
3. Student shall be eligible for promotion from first year to second year of course provided he/she has passed 50% papers of I and II semester taken together. However, he/she will have to clear remaining papers in second year.
4. Students who do not fulfill the above criterion are declared as fail in the Part concerned. However, they shall have the option to retain the marks in the papers in which they have secured Pass marks.
5. Student who has to reappear in paper for semester I/III may do so only in odd semester examination to be held in November/December.
6. Students who have to reappear in paper for semester II/IV may do so in even semester examination to be held in April/ May.

## REAPPEARANCE IN PASSED PAPERS

1. Reappearance in theory paper is allowed.
2. Reappearance in practical paper, dissertation, and field work is not allowed.
3. A Student may reappear in any theory paper prescribed for a semester, on foregoing in writing his/her previous performance in the paper/s concerned. This can be done in the immediate subsequent semester exam only, for example, a student reappearing in paper prescribed for semester examination I may do so along with semester III examination.
4. Students who have cleared part II (III & IV Semesters) may reappear only once at the immediate examinations on foregoing in writing his/her previous performance in the paper/s concerned within the prescribed span period.
5. Student who reappears in a paper shall carry forward the internal assessment marks, originally awarded.
