

DELHI UNIVERSITY COMPUTER CENTRE (DUCC)

Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC) is the hub for computer related services in the campus. Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC) is in a unique position to serve the University of Delhi for all its IT needs with the commissioning of the University-wide network. The network, consisting of a gigabit fiber backbone provides connectivity to all Departments at the North & South Campuses, all Colleges as well as 64 Off Campus Colleges.

There are over 11000 network access points at present. The services available to users include access to the internet through 36 Mbps bandwidth in North Campus and 24 Mbps in South Campus.

SERVICES

Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC) provides varied services to all faculty members, staff and students of University of Delhi.

1. **Email Services:** All University officials, faculty members of Departments and Colleges and research and post-graduate students of University of Delhi are provided with E-mail IDs. All mail services are accessible over both email clients (e.g. Outlook Express) and a web browser. The E-mail service is also being extended to College teachers of University of Delhi.

STEPS FOR CREATING E-MAIL ID

- Download Email Registration Form from the Website of Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC) i.e. www.ducc.du.ac.in
- Submit duly filled in form forwarded by Head of the Department/Principal of the College to the Director, DUCC. However, only Ph.D. students are required to get their forms verified from their supervisor as well.
- E-mail User ID & Password are emailed at the alternate E-mail ID provided by the applicant.

STEPS FOR RESETTING PASSWORD

- Send a written request to the Director, DUCC forwarded by Head of the Department/Principal of the College to the Director, DUCC.
- New password is emailed at the alternate E-mail ID provided by the applicant.

2. Web Hosting Services:

- Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC) provides hosting infrastructure and content management for the official website of University of Delhi i.e. www.du.ac.in as well as for internally hosted sites forming an intranet for the University.
- The Centre has also started providing space for hosting College websites. In addition, individual web pages of the University of Delhi community are hosted at www.people.du.ac.in
- Space for College or individual websites may be requested by writing to the Director, DUCC (director@ducc.du.ac.in).

UNIVERSITY OF DELHI COLLEGE DEPARTMENT, CENTRE OR EVENT WEBSITE & DATABASE HOSTING

- Send a request forwarded by the Head of the Department/ Principal of the College to the Director, DUCC through University of Delhi domain E-mail ID followed by a written request.
- Hosting services are available on Solaris Server with PHP support & My SQL Database.
- User ID & Password are sent in a sealed envelope to the Head/Principal of the College.

UNIVERSITY OF DELHI FACULTY MEMBER'S PERSONAL WEBPAGE HOSTING

- Send a request forwarded by the Head of the Department/Principal of the College to Director, DUCC through University of Delhi domain E-mail ID followed by a written request.
- User ID & Password are sent to the Faculty members in a sealed envelope.

STEPS FOR RESETTING PASSWORD

- Send a written request to the Director, DUCC forwarded by Head of the Department/Principal of the College to the Director, DUCC.
New password is sent in a sealed envelope.

STEPS FOR CONTENT UPLOADING ON THE WEBSITE OF UNIVERSITY OF DELHI i.e. www.du.ac.in

- Send a request forwarded by Head of the Department/Principal of the College to the Director, DUCC through University of Delhi domain E-mail ID followed by a written request along with hardcopy and softcopy on CD.

3. Anti -Virus & Spam Protection:

Anti-virus & Spam Protection is provided at the server and the gateway level for E-mail and web services. Additionally, all PCs in the University and Colleges that have been provided with connectivity

are required to have an anti-virus product installed on them with free virus subscription updates. The client software is downloadable from <http://download.du.ac.in/>.

4. Forum & Mailing Links:

The Centre supports access to forums (www.forums.du.ac.in) and listserv (www.lists.du.ac.in) type services on the campus intranet.

5. E- journals & On- line Database:

Access to popular scientific databases like Scifinder, Scopus is provided to faculty and students of University of Delhi. Additionally access to more than 350 electronic journals is provided (www.crl.du.ac.in).

6. E- prints & E- books Archives:

The E - prints server at www.eprints.du.ac.in provides the research community of University of Delhi with a repository for self-archiving their pre-prints and articles. E-books archive is there to provide an archive of useful E-books (such as those from the Gutenberg Project) at www.ebooks.du.ac.in. Desirable freely available E-book collections can be proposed by users for procurements by the Delhi University Computer Centre (DUCC).
