

# RULES FOR RELAXATION OR CONCESSION FOR ARMED FORCES/ SIKKIMESE STUDENTS

---

## ARMED FORCES

There is a provision of 5% of the seats in each course in the University of Delhi to the Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel. A concession of 5% marks in the minimum eligibility requirements in the qualifying examinations. The admission of candidates belonging to Children/Widows of the eligible Armed Forces Personnel (CW Category) has to be made in the following order of priorities as per the guidelines approved by the Academic Council:

- i. Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action,
- ii. Wards of serving personnel and ex-servicemen disabled in action;
- iii. Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to military service;
- iv. Wards of Defence personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to military service; and
- v. Wards of Ex-servicemen personnel and serving personnel including personnel of police forces who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.  
Category (v):- Gallantry Awards include: Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Sarvottam Yudh Seva Medal, Maha Vir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Uttam Yudh Seva Medal, Vir Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, Yudh Seva Medal, Sena, Nau Sena- Vayusena Medal, Mention-in-Despatches, President's Police Medal for Gallantry, Police Medal for Gallantry.
- vi. Such candidates shall be required to get their names registered for admission to various undergraduate courses at Room No. 218, New Administrative Block, North Campus, University of Delhi.
  - For purpose of registration, the candidates are required to submit their applications on a prescribed form available at the Registration Centre, along with two self-attested Photostat copies as well as the originals of the required certificates which shall be returned to them after verification of certificates.
  - The Children/ Widows/ of the Officers shall be required to submit the Certificate of educational concessions (in original) from anyone of the following authorities in order to become eligible for the above concessions:
    - Secretary, Kendriya Sainik Board, Delhi
    - Secretary, Rajya/ Zila Sainik Board

- Officer-in-Charge, Record Office
- First-Class Stipendiary Magistrate
- Ministry of Home Affairs (For police personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards)

### **SIKKIMESE STUDENTS**

The number of seats as detailed below are reserved for students from Sikkim nominated by the Government of Sikkim only in Colleges where hostel facilities are available.

- B.A.(Prog) – 3 seats
- B.A. (Hons.) – 1 seat
- B.Com– 4 seats
- B.Com. (Hons.) – 2 seats
- B.Sc. Physical Sciences – 2 seats
- B.Sc. Life Sciences – 2 seats
