

B. Tech. Humanities (Under Meta College Concept)

Q.1 When was B. Tech Humanities introduced by Cluster Innovation Centre in the University of Delhi?

Ans. B. Tech. Humanities, a four year degree course, was introduced in August 2012 by Cluster Innovation Centre in the University of Delhi.

Q.2 How many streams are available for specialization in B. Tech. Humanities in University of Delhi?

Ans. Specialization in B. Tech. Humanities is available in the following streams:

- Journalism
- Education
- Historical Tourism
- Counseling
- Art and Design

Q.3 What is the structure of the course in B. Tech. Humanities in University of Delhi?

Ans. A student is required to study core courses in Semester-I at Cluster Innovation Centre, and then he/she shall have the freedom to choose any one of the streams being offered by the University of Delhi. Students may choose one stream from the following:

- Journalism
- Education
- Historical Tourism
- Counseling
- Art and Design

A student is required to enroll in two papers of his/her choice within the range of courses available in different colleges, in each semester, from 2nd to the 7th semesters. A mentor shall be provided to guide the student in making appropriate selection of courses. A student is required to do two theoretical papers in college as well as undertake two innovation projects for each semester. A student can pursue a maximum of two semesters from any one college in the University of Delhi. In the 8th Semester the student will study core courses at Cluster Innovation Centre.

Q.4 What are the minimum eligibility criteria for taking admission in the B. Tech. Humanities course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The eligibility criteria for taking admission in B. Tech. Humanities are as follows:

- Candidate must have his/her Leaving Certificate (Class XII or equivalent) with a minimum aggregate marks as mentioned below (category wise) :
 - 60% in four subjects for candidates belonging to the General category.
 - 54% in four subjects for candidates belonging to the OBC category.
 - 55% in four subjects for candidates belonging to the PH category.
 - Passing marks for candidates belonging to the SC/ST category.

- Candidate must be currently enrolled in any programme of study in regular college, School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) in the University of Delhi.

Q.5 What is the admission procedure in B. Tech. Humanities course conducted by the Cluster Innovation Centre (CIC) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission procedure for B. Tech. Humanities course comprises of two steps which are as follows:

- A Written Test consisting of multiple choice questions, of two hours duration.
 - Interview for the short listed students.
- Weightage for the written exam :75%
 - Interview : 25%

Q.6 How many seats are available in B. Tech. Humanities course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The total number of seats available in B. Tech. Humanities course is forty (40) out of which reservation shall be given as per the norms laid down by the University of Delhi.

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q.7 From where can candidates obtain the application form for B. Tech. Humanities course in University of Delhi?

Ans. Candidates can download the application form from the website of University of Delhi, i.e. <http://www.du.ac.in> or the website of Cluster Innovation Centre, i.e. <http://www.cic.du.ac.in> . One can also collect the application form directly from the office of Cluster Innovation Centre, 3rd Floor, University Stadium, G C Narang Road, University of Delhi, Delhi -110007.

Q.8 When can one obtain the form for B. Tech. Humanities course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The form for B. Tech. Humanities course can be obtained tentatively in the month of June/July every year, as per the notification by University of Delhi. Students are advised to visit the official website of University of Delhi, i.e. <http://www.du.ac.in> or call University Information Centre (UIC) at 011-27006900 for more information.

Q.9 Can the students who have already enrolled in Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) and in the School of Open Learning (SOL) of 1st year apply for B. Tech. Humanities course?

Ans. Yes, the students already enrolled in 1st year of Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) or in the School of Open Learning (SOL), can apply for B. Tech. Humanities course as well.

Q.10 What is the fee structure for B. Tech. Humanities course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The fee for B. Tech. Humanities course per Semester is Rs.5000/- and Rs.1000/- which is refundable (Library Security) one time.
