Q.3 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for M.A. Sanskrit in the University of Delhi?

Ans. The eligibility criteria for M.A. Sanskrit in the University of Delhi are given below:

I. Direct Admission

B.A. (Hons.) Sanskrit of the University of Delhi with minimum 60% marks.

II. Through Admission Test.

Eligibility criteria for appearing in the admission test.

- B.A. (Hons.) Sanskrit from recognized University with minimum 40% marks.
- B.A. (Pass)/B.A. (Programme) or B.A. (Hons.) in Hindi of the University of Delhi or any recognized University with at least two papers of Sanskrit with 40% marks in aggregate.
- Acharya (Sanskrit) examination of recognized University/Deemed University and Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan with minimum 50% in marks in aggregate.
- Shastri (Sanskrit) examination of recognized University/Deemed University/Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan with minimum 50% in aggregate.
- B.A. (Hons.) examination in any subject of the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Sanskrit as subsidiary/concurrent subject with minimum 50% in Honors. and minimum 60% in Sanskrit Subsidiary/ Concurrent Subject.
- M.A. examination in Arts and Humanities (except Sanskrit) from University of Delhi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate.
- Master's degree in any subject from a recognized University with Diploma in Sanskrit from the University of Delhi with minimum 50% in aggregate and 50% in Sanskrit Diploma.

- Bachelor's degree of any recognized University and having a Diploma in Sanskrit from University of Delhi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in Diploma examination.
- Students securing 60% and above marks in admission Test shall be admitted to M.A. (Sanskrit) course according to merit list on the basis of available seats.

Q.4 What is the duration of entrance test for M.A. Sanskrit in the University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration of entrance test for M.A. Sanskrit in the University of Delhi is 2:30 hours.

Q.5 Is it compulsory for a student to give entrance test for admission if he/she wants to apply for hostel?

Ans. The merit list for hostel admission shall be prepared on the basis of admission Test. Those students who wish to apply in hostels would have to appear for the Written Test.

Q.6 What is the syllabus of the entrance test for M.A. Sanskrit in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission shall be based on the level of B.A. (Hons.) Sanskrit Examination in subjects like Literature, Grammar, Philosophy etc. The entrance test shall also include question from contemporary subject based on General Knowledge.

Q.7 What is the structure of the entrance test for M.A. Sanskrit in University of Delhi?

Ans. The entrance test for M.A. Sanskrit in University of Delhi shall consist of 100 marks. The format of question paper shall be as follow:

Sanskrit Essay on a topic like saying on Sanskrit authors such as Upama Kalidasasya, definition of Poetry according to Dandi, Vaman, Bhamaha/ Ramayana, Mahabharata, Kavyas Sukti, and on Contemporary issues	10 marks
Translation/Unseen passage	10 marks
Descriptive Questions from the subjects	10 marks
Objective type questions	70 marks
