Q.1 What is the mode of selection for admission in M.A. Hindi courses in the University of Delhi?

Ans. There is a dual mode of selection for admission in M.A. Hindi course in University of Delhi:

- Direct Admission
- Entrance Test

Q.2 What is the procedure of direct admission for M.A. Sanskrit in Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB)?

Ans. Candidates seeking admission to M.A. Sanskrit under direct Category may get themselves registered directly in both the Campuses and Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board.

Q.3 What is the procedure of entrance test admission for M.A. Sanskrit, M.A Hindi in NCWEB?

Ans. Candidates seeking admission to M.A in Hindi and Sanskrit through Entrance Test for both the campuses and Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board may get themselves registered in the Main Campus.

Q.4 Where can candidates see their Merit List of Direct Admissions for both campuses and NCWEB?

Ans. The admission lists on the basis of merit under direct category shall be finalized and displayed by both the Campuses & NCWEB independently.

Q.5 Where can candidates see their Merit List of Entrance Test for both campuses and NCWEB?

Ans. The merit list of both the Campuses and NCWEB shall be displayed on the respective Campus.

Q.6 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for M.A Hindi course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum eligibility criteria for M.A Hindi course in University of Delhi is given below:

Category I : Direct Admission i.e. Without Entrance Test

1.	B.A. (Hons.) Examination in Hindi from University of Delhi	60% & above marks
Category II : Admission Through Entrance Test		
S.No.	Course Requirement	Minimum Marks Requirements
1.	B.A. (Hons.) Examination in Hindi from University of Delhi	40% & above, but less than 60%
2.	B.A. (Hons.) Examination in Hindi from a recognized Indian University other than University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject.	40% & above
3.	B.A. (Pass)/B.A Programme/B.Com Examination from University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject.(minimum two papers in Hindi)	45% & above in aggregate and 50%in Hindi subject
4.	M.A. in Sanskrit(Language and Literature)from University of Delhi or any other examination	50% marks in M.A. and 50% marks in Hindi subject in B.A.

	recognized as equivalent thereto	
5.	M.A. in English, Modern Indian Languages (except Hindi), Linguistics, Sociology, History, Philosophy, Psychology, Political Science, Buddhist Studies, Journalism/Mass Communication	50% marks in M.A. and 50% marks in Hindi at B.A. level.
6.	B.A. in any subject from University of Delhi or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto (with minimum one paper in Hindi)	55% marks in B.A. with 50% marks in Hindi subject.

Q.7 Is it required for Category I and Category II to give entrance test for hostel accommodation in University of Delhi?

Ans. All the students are required to appear in the entrance test for hostel accommodation in University of Delhi.

Q.8 What is the minimum passing percentage required for entrance test of M.A Hindi in University of Delhi?

Ans. Candidates are required to score 40% in the Entrance Test in order to be eligible for admission in M.A. Hindi in University of Delhi. Relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD is given as per the University rules.

Q.9 Is there any different entrance test for NCWEB, SOL, main campus, South campus, Zakir Hussain College?

Ans. There shall be a common Entrance Test for admission to the M.A. programme for the Main Campus, the South Campus, NCWEB, SOL and Zakir Hussain College.

Q.10 What is the syllabus of entrance test for M.A Hindi in University of Delhi?

Ans. The Entrance Test is designed to test the proficiency of candidates in Hindi language (including Comprehension and Writing skills) and their basic knowledge of Hindi literature from 10th century to 20th century.

Q.11 What is the duration of entrance test for M.A Hindi in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration of entrance test for M.A Hindi in University of Delhi is of two hours.

Q.12 What is the structure of the entrance test for M.A Hindi in University of Delhi?

Ans. The entrance test comprises of two parts. The first part consists of subject related questions and second part consists of essay type questions.
