Q.1 What is the procedure of admission in M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The procedure of admission to M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi shall be done through two channels:

- (i) 50% seats by direct merit on the basis of marks obtained in B. Sc. (Hons.) Electronics, University of Delhi
- (ii) 50% seats by Entrance Test.

Q.2 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi are given below:

6.	B Sc. (Hons.) Physics Course from other Universities (after 10+2+3)	50% or above in aggregate
7.	B Sc.(Genl.) Course With Physics, Mathematics, Electronics from University of Delhi (after 10+2+3)	60% or above in aggregate
8.	B. Sc. (Genl.) Course With Physics, Mathematics, Electronics from other Universities (after 10+2+3)	60% or above in aggregate

Q.3 What is the total number of seats in M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The total number of seats in M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi is thirty two (32). 50% seats are based on quota marks and 50% seats are on the basis of merit in the Entrance examination.

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q.4 What is the allocation of seat for reserved categories in University of Delhi?

Ans. The allocation of seat for reserved categories in University of Delhi is given below:

	Category I	Category II
General	8	8
Scheduled Caste	3	3
Scheduled tribes	1	1
OBC	4	4
Total no. of seats	16	16

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q.5 What is the duration of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration of M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi is two (2) years.

Q.6 When can one apply for M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission to M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi is conducted by the Department of Electronics Science tentatively in the first/second week of July at University of Delhi South Campus, as per the notification.

Q.7 What is the duration of Entrance test in M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration of Entrance test in M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi is three (3) hours.

Q.8 What is the syllabus of entrance test for M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The entrance test for M.Sc. Electronics is based on the syllabus of eligibility courses of the University with emphasis on Electronics.

Q.9 What is the structure of entrance test for M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The entrance test for M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi consists of two sections:

- **Section A:** Objective – 120 marks
- **Section B:** Short Descriptive-30 marks

- **Total:** 150 marks

Q.10 Where can a candidate see their result of the entrance test for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The merit list of the candidates based on the entrance test for admission to this course shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Department of Electronics in University of Delhi.

Q.11 What is the minimum passing criteria in examination of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. There are four semesters in M.Sc. Electronics course in University of Delhi. The minimum pass marks shall be 40% in practical in each of the three semesters (I, II, III) and 40% in each theory papers, 40% in Project/Thesis and 40% in seminar in the IV semester. The minimum pass marks in summer training shall also be 40%.

Q.12 What is the minimum requirement of attendance for students of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum requirement of attendance for students of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi is two-third of the theory classes and three fourth of the practical classes.

Q.13 What happens if a student fails in any semester?

Ans. A student who fails in any semester shall join as a regular student over and above the allocated seats for the course.

Q.14 Is there any industrial training for students of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The students of M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi shall be required to go for industrial training for two months in summer vacation between II and III semester.

Q.15 What is the span period for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The span period for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi is four (4) years from the date of admission.

Q.16 What are the conditions in which the admission to M.Sc. Electronics shall be cancelled in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission of a student shall be cancelled if he/she is absent for two weeks continuously from the date of admission.

Q.17 What is the criteria of promotion in next semester for M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The student shall be promoted to next semester if he/she has not failed in more than two theory papers and has obtained not less than 40% marks in the aggregate of theory and practical taken separately.

Q.18 Is there any placement facilities for students in M.Sc. Electronics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The Department of Electronics Science arranges placement facilities for summer training and Project work in leading organizations in the private and public sector. Campus interviews are also arranged at the Department for the purpose of placement.
