Ans. The minimum eligibility criterion for M.A. Comparative Indian Literature is given below:

S.No.	Course Requirement	Minimum Marks Requirements
1.	B.A. (Hons.) in any Indian Language or English or Comparative Literature of the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject.	55% marks or above
2.	B.A. (Pass) of the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least three papers in any Indian language or English.	60% marks or above
3.	B.A. (Hons.) in any Indian Language or English or Comparative Literature of University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject.	50% marks or above
4.	B.A. (Pass) of the University of Delhi or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with at least three papers in any Indian Language or English.	55% marks or above
5.	M.A. in any Indian Language or English from University of Delhi or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto	50% marks or above
6.	Any graduate of the University of Delhi or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto provided he/she passes in a qualifying test which would be organized by the Department to test the candidate's aptitude for basic knowledge of Indian Literature.	55% marks or above
