Q.1 What is the structure of M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology in University of Delhi?

Ans. The Department of Plant Molecular Biology offers M.Sc.in Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology designed to encompass areas such as Plant Physiology and Biochemistry, Molecular Cell Biology, Prokaryotic Genetics, Eukaryotic gene regulation, Advanced Molecular Biology, Biotechnology, Genomics, Bio Informatics and IPR related issues.

Q.2 Which department offers M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The Department of Plant Molecular Biology under the Faculty of Inter Disciplinary & Applied Sciences offers M. Sc. in Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology in University of Delhi.

Q.3 What is the mode of admission in M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission to M.Sc. in Plant Molecular Biology and Biotechnology (PMBB) involves a written examination followed by an interview. Candidates are called for interview based on performance in written examination and the final selection is based on the combined performance in written exam and the interview.

Q.4 What is the total number of seats in M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology?

Ans. The total number of seats for admission to the M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology (PMBB) is twelve (12) (both General& Reserved categories).

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q.5 What is the tentative month of admission notifications for M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology?

Ans. The tentative month of admission notifications for M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology in University of Delhi is April/May every year.

Q.6 What is the syllabus of Written test (PMBB) examination?

Ans. The Written test (PMBB) comprises of multiple-choice questions in the following areas:

- Biological Sciences taught at undergraduate level,
- Basic knowledge of Physical and Chemical Sciences
- Data Interpretation
- General Awareness.

Q.7 What is the criteria for selection in Written test and Interview?

Ans. All admissions are made in the order of merit in each category, which is based on the total marks secured in the written test (Maximum marks-75) and the interview (Maximum marks- -25).

Q.8 Where can candidate see their result of Written test and interview?

Ans. The result of written test and Interview shall be displayed on the website of : www.dpmb.ac.in.

Q.9 What is the minimum eligibility criteria in M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum eligibility criteria in M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology & Biotechnology course is given below:

- A student seeking admission to this course must have passed Bachelor in Biological, Chemical or Physical Sciences with at least 60% marks in the main subject (in case of Hons. courses) or in aggregate (for other courses).
- Candidates must also have completed the 10+2+3 years of formal education.
- Candidates whose results have not been declared but are expecting to pass in the first division can also appear in the entrance test.
- Appropriate relaxation for candidates belonging to reserved category is applicable as per the University norms.
- No T.A. and D.A. shall be paid to appear in the written examination or interview.
