Q.1-What are the courses offered by the Department of Statistics in University of Delhi?

Ans-The courses offered by the Department of Statistics in University of Delhi are as follows:

- M.A/M. Sc. in Statistics
- M. Phil in Statistics
- Ph. D in Statistics

Q.2-What are the eligibility criteria for M.A /M. Sc. in Statistics in University of Delhi?

Q.3-How many seats are there in each course offered by the Department of Statistics in University of Delhi?

Ans-The seats offered by the Department of Statistics in University of Delhi is as follows:

Q.4-What is the provision of provisional admission in Department of Statistics in University of Delhi?

Ans-Those candidates who have appeared in the final year examination of their qualifying degree but their results have not been declared or the detailed mark-sheet have not been received shall be registered provisionally keeping in view their performance at the examination passed in the year preceding the final year examination. Such candidates shall be required to submit a bona fide certificate from the University last attended by them.

Q.5-What is the provision for admission of compartmental candidates in Department of Statistics in University of Delhi?

Ans-Candidates who have been placed under compartment by University of Delhi shall be allowed to register themselves for provisional admission to M.A/M.Sc. course in the Department of Statistics provided they fulfil other prescribed requirements of the course concerned.

Q.6-What is the rule to create merit list of Compartmental candidates in University of Delhi?

Ans-Merit of a candidate who has been placed under compartment either in subsidiary subject or in elective subject shall be determined on the basis of minimum pass marks in the subjects.

Q.7-What happen if a student fails to appear or fail to pass the compartment examination in University of Delhi?

Ans-Students who fail to appear or fail to pass the compartment examination shall not be allowed to continue on rolls and their provisional admission shall be cancelled without any correspondence with them.

Q.8- What is the admission procedure for foreign students in University of Delhi?

Ans- Foreign students seeking admission in Faculty of Mathematics are required to apply directly to the Deputy Dean, Foreign Students' Registry Office, Room No.11, First Floor, Conference Centre, University of Delhi, Delhi- 110007. Foreign Students who are stationed in India and have passed last examination from recognized Board/University in India may seek admission on the basis of merit along with other students after obtaining a No Objection Certificate from the Deputy Dean, Foreign Students Registry Office.

Q.9-What is the span period for M.A. /M. Sc. Program in University of Delhi?

Ans- The span period for M.A. /M. Sc. Program in University of Delhi is four (4) years from the date of admission.

Q.10- What is the provision for admission for Nepalese /Bhutanese students in M.A. /M. Sc. Program in University of Delhi?

Ans- Candidates sponsored by the Government of Nepal/ Government of Bhutan for admission to any M.A/M.Sc. course in the faculty shall be given the weightage of 5% in the minimum marks requirements. However, there shall not be any reservations of seat for such candidate for any course in University of Delhi.

Q.11-How many seats are reserved for SC/ST category in University of Delhi?

Ans-22.5% seats are reserved for SC/ST category in University of Delhi.

Q.12-How many seats are reserved for OBC students in University of Delhi?

Ans-27% seats are reserved for OBC students in University of Delhi.

Q.13-How many seats are reserved for PWD students in University of Delhi?

Ans-3% seats are reserved for PWD students in University of Delhi.

Q.14- Which college conducts these courses in University of Delhi?

Ans- The colleges which conduct these courses in University of Delhi are as follows:

North Campus	(i)Hindu College (ii)Ramjas College
South Campus	(i) Lady Shri Ram College for Women (ii) Sri Venkateswara College

Q.15-What are the scholar programs offered by the Department of Statistics in University of Delhi?

Ans-There are two scholarships under Ordinance XXVIII:

- **Post-graduate scholarship** –Post graduate scholarships not exceeding twenty in number each of the value of Rs.250/- p.m., shall be awarded each year in the Faculty of Arts, Science, Mathematical Sciences, Social Science ,Law ,Music and Fine Arts, Management studies for proceeding to the degree of M.A/M. Sc. /M.Com/M.B.A/L.L.M/L.L.B of the University of Delhi.

- **Sanjeev Kumar Singhal Memorial Scholarships**- There shall be two scholarships known as Sanjeev Kumar Singhal Memorial Scholarships, to be awarded each year to the M.A/M. Sc. Statistics students of the University of Delhi out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs.50, 000/- (Fifty Thousand) given by his father Dr. Kanwar Sen, Former Professor, Department of Statistics, University of Delhi.
