Q.1 Which College offer BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. Nehru Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Defence Colony, New Delhi offers the course in Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS).

Q.2 Where can one obtain the application form for BHMS in University of Delhi?

Ans. The candidates can obtain the application form for BHMS in University of Delhi from the Office of the Deputy Registrar, Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine, 6th floor, V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007. The form can also be downloaded from Websites www.fmssc.ac.in, www.du.ac.in and www.nhmc.delhigovt.nic.in.

Q.3 How many number of seats are available in Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) course?

Ans. The total number of seats available for admission in BHMS Course is 100 under different categories. The distribution of seats is as listed below:-

Q.4 What is the minimum age criteria for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. A candidate must have the minimum age of seventeen years as on 31st December, 2013 to apply for BHMS course in University of Delhi.

Q.5 What is the minimum educational qualifications for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum educational qualification for BHMS course in University of Delhi is given below:

- **For 85% Delhi Quota Seats:** The candidates must have passed Intermediate/ Senior School Certificate Examination (CBSE)/Indian School Certificate Examination (12 years course) or any other equivalent

Examination recognized by the University of Delhi for admission to Under- graduate courses with 60% or more marks in an aggregate of three subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and must have passed English as one of the subject from a recognized school conducting regular classes situated within the National Capital Territory of Delhi (except Patrachar Vidyalaya and Open School).

- **For 15% All India Quota Seats (except Delhi quota)** : The candidates from all over India who have passed 10+2 examination with 60% or more marks in an aggregate of three subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and must have passed English as one of the subject (except Patrachar Vidyalaya and Open School).
- **For OBC candidates:** Candidate must have obtained 54% marks in Class XIIth examination.
- **For SC/ST candidates:** Candidate must have obtained 50% marks in Class XIIth examination.

Note: The candidate belonging to General PH category must have secured a minimum of 55% marks.

Q.6 What is the medium of instruction and examination in BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The medium of instruction and examination in BHMS course is English in University of Delhi.

Q.7 What are the documents required to be attached along with application form for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The following documents are required to be attached along with application form for BHMS course:

- Secondary School (10th Class) Certificate and its Marks Sheet.
- Senior School (12th Class) Certificate and its Marks Sheet.
- Separate Certificate for Date of birth, if it is not shown in the 10th Class Certificate.
- Original Character Certificate, from the Head of the Institution last attended (Not older than six months)
- Passing Hindi Certificate (Marks Sheet) for all candidates who have studied upto 8th standard applying for BHMS Course for purpose of award of degree.
- Caste Certificate of OBC/SC/ST/PH (if applicable).
- Entitlement Certificate for Defence Personnel (if applicable).

Q.8 Where can a candidate see his/her result for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The **merit for finalization** to BHMS course shall be displayed on the Notice boards of the Faculty Office, or on the website of Faculty of Medical Sciences i.e. www.fmssc.ac.in.

Q.9 What is the duration for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration for BHMS Course is five and half years (including Internship Training for twelve months) in the University of Delhi.

Q.10 What is the fee structure for BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The fee structure for BHMS course in University of Delhi is given below:

- At the time of admission (July) -1st Year (18 months): Total Fee- Rs.3120/-*
- 2nd, 3rd and 4th Year in the month of April: Rs.1250/-*

***Fee is subject to change.**

Q.11 What is the procedure for withdrawal of admission as well as refund of fees in BHMS course?

Ans. Candidate can apply for the withdrawal of admission within the date specified in Bulletin of Information. Their money shall be refunded for BHMS course as per the guidelines notified by the University of Delhi.

Note: The amount required to be deposited with the Govt. of NCTD shall not be refunded.

Q.12 Are the candidates of compartment result and re-appeared eligible for admission in BHMS course?

Ans. Candidates who have appeared in the Class XII Examination this year i.e. 2013 and have been placed under Compartment or are to re-appear for improvement shall not be eligible for admission in BHMS course in University of Delhi.

Q.13 Is migration allowed in BHMS course in University of Delhi?

Ans. No, there is no procedure of Inter University Migration to 2nd year of BHMS Course under Faculty of Homeopathic Medicines in University of Delhi.
