**Q.1 What are the courses offered by the Faculty of Inter Disciplinary & Applied Sciences in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The following courses are offered by the Faculty of Inter Disciplinary & Applied Sciences:

- M.Sc. Biochemistry
- M.Sc. Electronics
- M.Sc. Genetics
- M.Sc. Informatics
- M.Sc. Microbiology
- M.Sc. Plant Molecular Biology

## Department of Biochemistry

**Q.2 What is the structure of M.Sc. Biochemistry course in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The students are offered advanced level theory and practical courses in Enzymes, Proteins, Biochemical and Biophysical Techniques, Molecular Biology, Cell Biology, Genetic Engineering, Immunology, Developmental Biology, Metabolomics, Proteomics and Bioinformatics.

**Q.3 What is the duration of M.Sc. Biochemistry course in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The duration for M.Sc. Biochemistry course in University of Delhi is two years.

**Q.4 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for M. Sc. Biochemistry in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The minimum eligibility criteria for M. Sc. Biochemistry in University of Delhi are given below:

<b>Eligibility Category</b>	<b>Course requirements</b>	<b>Marks requirement</b>
1.	B. Sc. (Hons.) in Biochemistry from University of Delhi	60% marks and above.
2.	B.Sc. (Hons.) in Biomedical Sciences or B.Sc. (Hons.) Biological Science from University of Delhi	60% marks and above.
3.	B. Sc. (Hons.) Botany and or Zoology with Chemistry as one of the subsidiary subject from University of Delhi	60% marks and above.
4.	B. Sc. (Hons.) Biochemistry from all other UGC approved Universities	60% marks and above.
5.	B. Sc. (Hons.) in Biotechnology from all other UGC approved Universities	60% marks and above.

**Q.5 What is the minimum age requirement for M. Sc. Biochemistry in University of Delhi?**

Ans. There is no minimum age bar for admission in M. Sc. Biochemistry course in the University of Delhi and its colleges except in professional courses where the regulatory body has prescribed minimum age requirement (such as MCI, AICTE etc.)

**Q.6 What is the provision for admission of a candidate who has compartment in one of the subjects by the University of Delhi?**

Ans. The candidates who have been placed under compartment in one of the subjects by the University of Delhi shall be allowed to register themselves for provisional admission to M A. /M. Sc. Course in University of Delhi.

**Q.7 What is the provision for admission of a candidate who has compartment in one of the subjects by other Universities?**

Ans. The candidates from other Universities who have been placed under compartment shall not be eligible for admission.

**Q.8 What happens if a candidate fails in the compartmental/subsidiary examination?**

Ans. The students who fail in the compartmental/subsidiary examination held in September/October shall not be allowed to continue on the rolls and their provisional admission shall be cancelled without any communication.

**Q.9 What is the procedure of admission in M.Sc. course for foreign students in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The Foreign students seeking admission to various courses are required to apply directly to the Deputy Dean, Foreign Students Registry Office, Room No.11, First Floor, Conference Centre, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007. The office shall arrange for their admission to various courses in the Colleges/Departments, as per the University rules.

**Q.10 What is the procedure of admission for candidates from Nepal/Bhutan in M. Sc. Course in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The candidates sponsored by the Governments of Nepal/Bhutan for admission to M.A. / M. Sc. and M.Com courses shall be given 5% relaxation in the minimum marks requirement but there shall be no reservation of seats for such candidates for any course in University of Delhi.

**Q.11 Is there any scholarship for M. Sc. Students in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The scholarships available for M. Sc. Students in University of Delhi are as follows:

- (i) South Campus Endowment Scholarship
- (ii) Monsanto Scholarship
- (iii) Rotary Club Scholarship
- (iv) All India Post Graduate Scholarship
- (v) University Post Graduate Scholarship

**Q.12 What is the total numbers of seats for M. Sc. Students in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The total number of seats for M. Sc. Students in University of Delhi is twelve (12).

**Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.**

**Q.13 What is the criteria of admission in M. Sc. Course in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The admission in M. Sc. Course in University of Delhi shall be based on marks and merit list.
