Q.1 Which Institute offers M.Sc. Informatics under the Faculty of Inter Disciplinary & Applied Sciences in University of Delhi?

Ans. Institute of **Informatics & Communication (IIC)** offers M.Sc. Informatics under the Faculty of **Inter** Disciplinary & Applied Sciences in University of Delhi.

Q.2 What is the purpose of M.Sc. Informatics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The two-year post-graduate degree course provides students theoretical knowledge **and** practical skills relating to Computers, Programming languages, Graphics and Multimedia applications, Telecommunication systems, Networking, and management of Information systems. The students, after completing the two-year course, are **expected to** attain a good background in conventional computer programming, and expertise in computers and telecommunication networks.

Q.3 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Informatics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The candidate **must have passed from the University of Delhi with any of the** following degrees or have equivalent qualification from a recognized* University / **Institutions with at least 50% marks in aggregate.**

- Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 scheme (B.Sc. /B.Sc. (H)/B. Appl. Sc.) in Physical Sciences or Chemical Science or Electronic Sciences or Mathematical Sciences or Computer Sciences or any combinations of subjects with at least two from these disciplines.
- B.E./B.Tech. degree in any discipline

Q.4 What is the minimum age limit for candidates in M.Sc. Informatics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The applicant must be at least 20 years of age as on 1st October in the year of taking admission. Relaxation up to one year is permissible only with the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

Q.5 Are appearing students eligible for M.Sc. Informatics course in University of Delhi?

Ans. The students appearing for their final year exams are also eligible for the entrance test, but they shall have to produce the provisional certificate of results by the concerned **year.**

Q.6 Is there any special class procedure in this course if the student comes from different disciplines?

Ans. A Zero Semester of about one-month has been introduced to bring students from different disciplines at par before starting the regular courses. During the Zero Semester, students take courses in topics in which they do not have an adequate background and are exposed to laboratory and Internet.

Q.7 Is there any examination after Zero Semester?

Ans. A student has to take a minimum of two papers in the examination after Zero Semester and depending upon the background, he/she may be advised to take more than two papers. Zero semester papers do not carry any credit for the purpose of classification of results. This period is also used for training students needing financial assistance to work as Teacher or Administrative Assistants.

Q.8 What is the span period for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The span period for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is four years.

Q.9 What is the total number of seats for M .Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The total numbers of seats (including reserved seats) for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is sixty two (62).

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q.10 What is the number of seats for reserved categories in University of Delhi?

Ans. The numbers of seats for the reserved categories are mentioned below:

- 15% of the seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC) candidates.
- 7.5% of the seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates.
- 5% of the seats are reserved for Children/Widows of the officers and men of Armed Forces including Para-military personnel killed/disabled in action.
- 3% of the seats are reserved for physically handicapped (PH) candidates.
- Relaxation to the extent of 5% marks in the minimum marks for eligibility to the entrance test and qualifying for Group discussion and Interview shall be allowed to the above categories..
- For OBC (Non Creamy Layer) candidates, seats are reserved as per the University Norms.

Q.11 Where can candidate obtain the application form for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The application form along with Information Bulletin can be obtained personally or by post on sending a request along with the requisite demand draft, from the office of Institute of Informatics & Communication (IIC), University of Delhi South Campus, Benito Juarez Road, New Delhi-110021.

Q.12 What is the procedure of selection for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The procedure of selection for M.Sc. (Informatics) is based on written admission test for all the eligible candidates (including the students whose results are awaited). The entrance test name is ICET.

Q.13 What is the structure of entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is based on multiple-choice type questions. The question paper comprises two parts and the duration is three hours.

Q.14 What is the syllabus of entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The syllabus of entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is given below: Part I: General English Comprehension, Analytical Ability and Reasoning. Part II: Mathematics, Physics and Electronics & Basic knowledge of Computers.

Q.15 What is the distribution of marks in the entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The distribution of marks in each part of the entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is mentioned below:

PART-1 Marks: 30

- Vocabulary and Comprehension: 10.
- Analytical Ability and Reasoning: 20.

PART-II Marks: 120

- Mathematics -40
- Physics -40
- Electronics and Basic knowledge of Computer- 40

Q.16 What is the procedure of admission after entrance test for M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The selected candidates from General and Reserved categories who qualify the written test shall be called in the order of merit for Group Discussion and Interview to be held at the University of Delhi South Campus, New Delhi-110021.

Q.17 What is the admission procedure for students whose results are awaited?

Ans. The candidates whose results are awaited may be provisionally allowed to appear in the interview upon giving an undertaking.

Q.18 What is the basis of final selection for admission in M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The final selection for admission in M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi shall be based on the following criteria:

- Written test: 75% Weightage
- Group Discussion and Interview: 25% Weightage.

Q.19 What is the fee structure for M.Sc. (Informatics) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The fee for various courses is payable at the beginning of each semester. The approximate fee per semester for M. Sc. Informatics is Rs. 7500/- (approx.)

***Fee is subject to change.**

Q.20 Is there any placement facility for M.Sc. (Informatics) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The students of M.Sc. (Informatics) have been well placed in Government, Public, Private and Multinational organization through Campus interviews such as Aricent Technologies, IBM Global System, HCL, Wipro Technologies, Infosys Technologies, Alca-Tel, Sapient, Conexant, Com viva Technologies, Hughes Systique and many more.

Q.21 Is there any hostel facility available for students in the University of Delhi?

Q.22 What is the structure of M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi?

Ans. The structure of M.Sc. Informatics in University of Delhi is as follows:

- The seven credit papers comprise three hours theory, one hour tutorial and three hours practical in a week.
- The four credit papers do not have practical. A candidate has to clear theory and practical separately.
- A minimum of 138 credits are required for M.Sc. (Informatics).
