Q.1 Which Colleges offer M.A.in Music in University of Delhi?

Ans. The Colleges which offer M.A.in Music in University of Delhi are as follows:

- (i) Daulat Ram College
- (ii) Hindu College
- (iii) Indraprastha College For Women
- (iv) Miranda House
- (v) Ramjas College

Q.2 What is the duration of M.A.in Music in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration of M.A.in Music in University of Delhi is two years.

Q.3 When can one obtain the application form for M.A. in Music in University of Delhi?

Ans. The application form for M.A. in Music in University of Delhi can be obtained tentatively in the month of July every year, as per the notification of University of Delhi.

Q.4 Where can one obtain the application form for M.A. in Music in University of Delhi?

Ans. The application form for M.A. in Music in University of Delhi can be obtained from the Department of Music, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007. The form can also be downloaded from the website of Faculty of Music and Fine Arts i.e. music.du.ac.in

Q.5 What is the structure of M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. The M.A programme is divided into two parts as under. Each part will consist of two Semesters to be known as Semester I and Semester II for Part-I; and Semester III and Semester IV for Part-II.

Part-I	First Year	Semester-I	Semester II
Part-II	Second Year	Semester -III	Semester-IV

Q.6 What is the scheme of examination for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. The scheme of examination for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi is as follows:

- The medium of instruction and examination shall be either English, or Hindi.
- Examinations shall be conducted at the end of each Semester as per the Academic calendar notified by the University of Delhi.
- The system of evaluation shall be as follows:

- Each course shall carry 100 marks, of which 30 marks shall be reserved for internal assessment based on tests, seminar, term courses and attendance etc. No student shall be allowed to appear in the end Semester if he/she has not participated in class tests, seminars, term courses etc. and has not been awarded the marks of internal assessment. For reappearing in the next applicable semester the candidate shall be required to attend regular classes in the concerned semester and fulfill all the activities related to internal assessment. No special classes shall be conducted for him/her during other semesters.
- The remaining 70 marks in each paper shall be awarded on the basis of practical/ written examination at the end of each semester. The duration of written examination for each paper shall be three hours and for practical minimum half an hour for each candidate.
- Examinations for courses shall be conducted only in the respective odd and even Semesters as per the Scheme of Examinations. Regular as well as Ex-Students shall be permitted to appear / reappear / improve in courses of Odd Semesters only at the end of Odd Semesters and courses of Even Semesters only at the end of Even Semesters.

Q.7 What is the span period for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. The span period for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi is four years from the date of admission to the Part-I of the M.A. Programme.

Q.8 What is the attendance requirement for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. No student shall be considered to have pursued a regular course of study unless he/she is certified by the Head of the Department of Music, University of Delhi, to have attended 75% of the total number of lectures, tutorials and seminars conducted in each semester, during his/her course of study, provided that he/she fulfills other conditions. The Head, Department of Music may permit a student to the next Semester who falls short of the required percentage of attendance by not more than 10 % of the lectures, tutorials and seminars conducted during the semester.

Q.9 What is the pass percentage for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum marks for passing the examination in each semester shall be 40% in each paper and 45% in aggregate of a semester. However, a candidate who has secured the minimum marks to pass in each paper but has not secured the minimum marks to pass in aggregate may reappear in any of the paper/s of his choice in the concerned semester in order to be able to secure the minimum marks prescribed to pass the semester in aggregate.

Q.10 What is the promotion criteria for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi?

Ans. The promotion criteria for M.A. in Music programme in University of Delhi are as follows:

- SEMESTER TO SEMESTER: Students shall be required to fulfill the Promotion Criteria Part to Part. Within the same Part, students shall be allowed to be promoted from a Semester to the next Semester, provided she/he has passed at least half of the courses of the current semester.
- PART TO PART: I to II: Admission to Part-II of the Programme shall be open only to those students who have successfully passed at least 75% papers out of papers offered for the Part-I courses comprising of Semester I and Semester II taken together. However, he/she will have to clear the remaining papers while studying in Part-II of the programme.
