

Master in Physical Education (M. P. Ed)

Q.1-What are the eligibility criteria for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The eligibility criteria for M. P. Ed. (as per NCTE norms & standard) is as follows:

- A candidate seeking admission to the two years M. P. Ed. (four semesters) degree course must have passed B.Sc. (Physical Education, Health Education & Sports)/B.P.Ed with at least 55% marks in aggregate.
- The candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examination are required to attach a document of proof for the same, with their application form.

Q. 2-When can one obtain the form for M. P .Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The candidates can obtain the form for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi tentatively in the month of May/ June, as per the notification of University of Delhi.

Q.3-What is the application fee for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The application fee for M. P. Ed is Rs.700/- for General category and Rs.400/- for SC/ST Category respectively*.

***Fee is subject to change.**

Q. 4-How many seats are available in M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans-The seats available for M. P. Ed course in the University of Delhi is thirty-nine (39).

Note: Seats are subject to change by the University of Delhi.

Q. 5- Where can a student collect the application form and prospectus for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- A student can collect the application form and prospectus from Indira Gandhi Institute of Physical Education and Sports Sciences (IGIPSS), Vikaspuri, New Delhi.

Q.6-What is the price of prospectus along with application form for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The price of prospectus along with application form is Rs.175/- when collected in person and Rs.200/- to be sent by post*.

Q. 7-What is the mode of payment for application form for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- There are various mode of payment for application form for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi. A student can pay by cash if he/she visits the college and collects the application form. If a student wants the application form and prospectus by post then, he/she can send a Demand Draft in favor of "IGIPSS-Admission Account - UG" payable at New Delhi.

Q. 8- Is there any other mode of payment admissible for students residing outside Delhi?

Ans- Other mode of payment such as Cheque /Money Order/Postal Order shall not be accepted. The candidate should write his/her name and form number on the reverse of the bank draft before sending the application by mail.

Q.9-What are the documents required to be attached at the time of submission of the application form?

Ans- The documents required to be attached at the time of submission of the application form are as follows:

- (i) Cash payment receipt of the Entrance Test Fee.
- (ii) Self -attested copies of all Certificates / Mark sheets.
- (iii) Three passport size photographs (two self-attested affixed on the application form and one without attestation on the Attendance Card).
- (iv) No Objection Certificate from the current employer (in case of employed candidates).

Q. 10-What is the admission procedure for M. P. Ed course in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The admission procedure for M. P. Ed course is done through an entrance examination. The components of entrance examination are listed below:

1. **Written Test:** 60 Marks (Based on the prescribed Syllabus through objective mode)
2. **Sports Proficiency:** 10 Marks
3. **Physical Fitness Test:** 05 Marks (Refer Physical Fitness Test Marking Scheme)
(Canadian Test)
4. **Playing Ability Test:** 15 Marks (Conducted by the PG Admission Committee)
5. **Interview:** 10 Marks (Conducted by the PG Admission Committee)
6. **Medical Examination:** Qualifying (Conducted by the Department of Physical Education & Sports Sciences, University of Delhi)

Q.11-What is the Physical Fitness Test marking scheme for B. P. Ed and M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans-The Physical Fitness Test marking scheme for B. P. Ed and M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi is as follows:

Q. 12- What is the syllabus for written test in M. P. Ed course in the University of Delhi?

Ans-The written test shall carry a weightage of 60 Marks comprising some questions based on the following syllabus. The Written test shall be based on Multiple Choice Questions.

The tentative area of syllabus of M. P. Ed is as follows:

1. Meaning, Definitions, Need, Importance, Objectives & Principles of Physical Education
2. Foundations of Physical Education: Biological, Sociological, Psychological. Scientific basis of Physical Education, Exercise Science and Sports.
3. Meaning, need and importance of fitness and wellness.
4. Career Avenues; National and International awards and Honors.
5. Meaning, Definitions, need & importance of anatomy, physiology, biomechanics, kinesiology & physiology of exercise in Physical Education.
6. Structure and functions on the following systems:
Cardiovascular System, Digestive System, Respiratory System, Nervous System, Endocrine System and Excretory System, Effects of exercise on the above systems.
7. Meaning of management; sports management, teaching, coaching, officiating careers in Physical Education & Sports.
8. Fundamental skills, and rules & regulations in various games and sports.
9. Grounds: Preparation and marking of standard play areas and courts in sports; and athletic track.
10. Health-meaning, dimensions of health and their interrelationships, factors influencing health.
11. Health Education- meaning, scope, aims and objectives, principles, methods and media used in health education, Hygiene. Nutrients- sources, functions and requirements, balanced diet
12. Definitions, causes including the mode of spread and prevention of communicable and non-communicable diseases, Immunization schedule.
13. Definition of first aid, DRABCH of first aid, CPR
14. Introduction to Sport Psychology: Meaning and scope, Importance, relationship with other sport sciences
15. Growth & Development: Concept of growth & development, physical and motor development, mental development.
16. Importance, definition, aims and objectives, characteristics & principles of Sports training
17. Components of health and sports related fitness
18. Meaning, aim & objectives, importance of kinesiology for physical education and sports.
19. Olympic Games, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games, National Games, IOA, IOC, WADA.
20. Latest sporting events.
21. General knowledge related to games & sports.

Q. 13- What is the required attendance for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The required attendance for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi is 80%.

Q.14-What is the tentative fee for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans-The tentative fee for M. P. Ed is Rs.7391/-.*

Q.15-What are the documents required at the time of admission for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi?

Ans- the documents required at the time of admission for M. P. Ed in the University of Delhi are as follows:

- (i) High School/Secondary School Certificate for the verification of Date of Birth.
- (ii) Statement of Marks in the Qualifying examination passed.
- (iii) Provisional/Degree Certificate in the Qualifying examination passed.
- (iv) Character Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- (v) Sports Representation/Achievement Certificates(s)
- (vi) In case of In-service candidates, No-Objection Certificate along with the leaving certificate sanctioned for the entire course duration.
- (vii) Caste Certificate, to be issued by the competent authority (wherever applicable).

Q.16- Is there any self-financing course offered by IGIPESS?

Ans-The Indira Gandhi Institute of Physical Education & Sports Sciences Institute is likely to start the following two Self Financing Certificate Courses which shall be of 80 Hours duration each:

1. Holistic Personality Development.
2. Yoga Education.
