PRACTICE OF MEDICINE

ORGANON OF MEDICINE & HOMEOPATHIC PHILOSOPHY

Q.1 What are the post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. There are two post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine which is given below:

- Practice of Medicine
- Organon of Medicine & Homeopathic Philosophy

Q.2 What is the procedure for admission in post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission shall be on the basis of entrance test in the Postgraduate degree courses and the test shall be conducted by the University of Delhi. The entrance test is given by the name Post – Graduate Medical Entrance Test Homeopathy (PGMET).

Q.3 Where can one obtain the application form for post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The candidates can obtain the application form for post graduate courses from the Office of the Deputy Registrar (Medical), Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine, 6th floor V.P. Chest Institute Building, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007. The application form can also be downloaded from the website of Faculty of Medical Sciences i.e. www.fmsc.ac.in and www.nhmc.delhigovt.nic.in

Q.4 What is the medium of instruction and examination in post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The medium of instruction and examination in post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi is English.

Q.5 Is there a procedure for rechecking the answer sheet of PGMET (Homeo.) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The candidates may apply for rechecking of their answer sheets within seven days from the date of declaration of PGMET (Homeo.) result on the payment of Rs.750/- on the prescribed form available at the office of the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicines. If there is any change in the result after re-checking, the candidate concerned shall be informed accordingly before counseling.

Q.6 Is Medical examination mandatory for selected candidates for postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. Yes, the selected candidates are required to undergo a medical examination by a duly constituted Medical Board at the assigned institution at their own cost on the specified date.

Q.7 How many seats are available in two post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine?

Ans. The following seats are available in two postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine which are as follows:

- (i) Practice of Medicine - 02 Seats
- (ii) Organon of Medicine & Homeopathic Philosophy - 02 Seats

Note: Reservation as per the University rules.

Q.8 What is the scheme of distribution of seats in post graduate courses in University of Delhi?

Ans. 50% of the total seats in Homeopathic Post Graduate Courses (per specialty) is reserved for candidates who have passed BHMS from the University of Delhi and the rest 50% of the total seats are open to the candidates who have passed BHMS from other recognized Universities in India except University of Delhi. If any of the seats remains vacant under All India Quota, the same shall be transferred to Delhi Quota.

Q.9 What is the duration of two post graduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The duration for the courses shall that be of three years including one year of house job.

Q.10 What is the minimum eligibility criteria for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The minimum eligibility criteria for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi are as follows:

- Candidate must have passed the degree of Bachelor of Homeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) from the University of Delhi or any other University recognized by the Central Council of Homeopathy.
- Candidates should have obtained permanent registration from the Board of Homeopathic System of Medicine.

Q.11 Are these Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine course applicable for students who are employed?

Ans. No, they cannot pursue this course along with employment, but the in-service candidate who appears in PGMET (Homeo.) should submit their application through a proper channel or else attach a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their employer to the effect that they have no objection and the candidate shall be relieved or granted with study leave for pursuing the course.

Q.12 What is the procedure of examination for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The examination for Postgraduate courses shall be conducted in two parts which are as follows:

- M.D.(Homeopathy) Part I, which is to be held in six months after completion of Junior Residency which is of one year's duration(i.e. one year and six month of admission).
- M.D. (Homeopathy) Part II, which is to be held after one year and six month of Part I examination.

Q.13 What is the criteria for entrance test for admission in Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The admission in Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine is on the basis of merit in the entrance test.

The minimum qualifying marks in the Entrance Test shall be 50% i.e.60 out of 120 marks for General Category ,48 marks of 120 i.e. 40% marks in case of SC/ST and 45% in the case of OBC Candidate.

Q.14 What is the syllabus for Postgraduate Medical Entrance Test (PGMET- Homeo.) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The syllabus for Postgraduate Medical Entrance Test (PGMET -Homeo.) in University of Delhi is given below:

- **Part A- Pre and Para-Clinical subjects** i.e. Anatomy, Physiology and Bio-Chemistry, Pathology and Microbiology, Forensic Medicine and Toxicology. It shall contain 30 multiple choice questions of one mark each.
- **Part B- Clinical Subjects** i.e. General Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy, Radio-Diagnosis, Community Medicine, Pulmonary Medicine, Psychiatry, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmology and Otorhinolaryngology. It shall contain 30 multiple choice questions of one mark each.
- **Part C -Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon & Homeopathic Philosophy, Repertory.** It shall contain 60 multiple choice questions of one mark each.

Q.15 What are the documents required to be attached along with application form for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The list of documents required to be attached along with application form for Postgraduate Courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine are as follows:

- High School /Higher Secondary (10th class) Certificate for verification of Date of birth.
- Certificate in support of educational qualification: B.H.M.S. Degree.
- Detailed marks Certificate of qualifying examination: I, II & Final Professional Examination of BHMS.
- The compulsory rotating Internship Certificate.
- Registration Certificate from Board of Homoeopathic System of Medicine.
- Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe /OBC Certificate, if applicable.
- Physically Handicapped Certificate, if applicable.
- Employer's Certificate along with No Objection Certificate (NOC), if employed (as given in the application form).

Q.16 Where can one see the result for PGMET (Homeo.) in University of Delhi?

Ans. The result for PGMET (Homeo.) of eligible candidates shall be notified on the Notice Board of the Faculty of Medical Sciences as well as on the website of the Faculty i.e. www.fmssc.ac.in tentatively within ten (10) days from the date of Entrance Test.

Q.17 Can the parents of a candidate come for admission if he/she is selected for counseling?

Ans. No, only the candidate is required to be present during the counseling for admission.

Q.18 What is the fee structure for the Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The total fee for the Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi is: Draft One- Rs.14, 135/- & Draft Two- Rs.1, 465/-. Total- Rs. 15, 600/-

Q.19 Is it required to pay Bond Money for students under Postgraduate courses in University of Delhi?

Ans. Yes, the student shall have to pay the Bond Money of 5.0 lakhs to the Institution/University in the following circumstances:-

- If the student does not join the course at the institution on or before the stipulated date.
- If the student leaves the course before its completion.
- If the admission/registration of the student is cancelled /terminated by the University on account of unsatisfactory performance/misconduct/indiscipline.

Q.20 What is the procedure to procure the documents if a student wants his/her Original Certificate before the stipulated time period?

Ans. No, the student cannot get their Original Certificate before the stipulated time period. The Original Certificates of the student would be kept in the custody of the admitting Institution and would be returned only after completion of the course or on payment of Bond money, whatever the case may be.

Q.21 Is there any stipend which is given to the students of Postgraduate courses?

Ans. Yes, a stipend shall be paid to the students pursuing Postgraduate courses in Homeopathy as per the rules of Government of NCT of Delhi.

Q.22 What is the span period for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi?

Ans. The span period for Postgraduate courses offered by the Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine in University of Delhi is five (5) years from the admission to the courses.
