

POSTGRADUATE EXAMINATIONS

Q.1- What is the minimum marks required to pass in any semester of post-graduation in University of Delhi?

Ans-The minimum marks required to pass any course in a semester shall be 40% in theory and 40% in practical, wherever applicable. The student must secure 40% in the End semester examination and 40% in the total of end semester examination as well as in the internal assessment of the course for both theory & practical separately.

Q.2-Is there any procedure to detain a student from the semester if he/she is not able to clear all the exams in Ist /IIIrd semester examination in University of Delhi?

Ans- No Students shall be detained in I and III semester on the basis of his/her performance in I or III semester examination; i.e. the student shall be promoted automatically from I to II and III to IV semester in University of Delhi.

Q.3- What is the promotion criteria from first year to another year in University of Delhi?

Ans- A Student shall be eligible for promotion from 1st year to 2nd year of the course provided he /she has passed 50% papers of I and II semester taken together. However, he/ she shall have to clear the remaining papers while studying in the 2nd year of the programme in University of Delhi.

Q.4- What happens if a student is not able to fulfill the promotional criteria in University of Delhi?

Ans- Students who do not fulfill the promotion criteria shall be declared fail in the part concerned. However, they shall have the option to retain the marks in the papers in which they have secured the pass marks.

Q.5-When can a student attempt to reappear examination in University of Delhi?

Ans- A student who has to reappear in a course prescribed for semester I/III may do so only in the odd semester examination to be held in November/December. A student who has to reappear in a course prescribed for semester II/IV may do so only in the even semester examinations to be held in April/May, as per the notification of University of Delhi.

Q.6-Can a student reappear in all theory papers in University of Delhi?

Ans- A student may reappear in any theory course prescribed for a semester on foregoing in writing her/ his previous performance in the paper/s concerned. This can be done only once in the immediate subsequent semester examination only (For example, A student who wants to reappear in a course prescribed for semester I examination, may do so along with the immediate next semester III examination only).

Q.7-What is the maximum time to appear for examination in University of Delhi?

Ans- A candidate who has cleared the papers of Part 2 (III & IV) may reappear in any course of III or IV semester only once, at the immediate subsequent examination on foregoing in writing his/ her previous performance in the paper/s concerned, within the prescribed span period.

(NOTE: The candidate of this category shall not be eligible to join any higher course of study)

Q.8-What is the basis on which results are prepared in University of Delhi?

Ans- The result shall be prepared on the basis of candidate's current performance in the examination in case of reappearance in a paper in University of Delhi.

Q.9-Which marks shall be considered if a student is not able to appear in examination, after submission of the forms of improvement in University of Delhi?

Ans- In the case of a candidate, who opts to re-appear in any paper/s, on surrendering her/his earlier performance but fails to re-appear in the paper/s concerned, the marks previously secured by the candidate in the paper/s in which she/he has failed to re-appear shall be taken into account while determining her / his result of the examination held currently in University of Delhi.
