

Procedure for Revaluation

Q.1- What is the procedure for Revaluation in University of Delhi?

Ans- Students are required to fill an application form for revaluation which is available on the official website of University of Delhi i.e. www.du.ac.in . They must get it attested from the Principal of the concerned College and then submit the application along with mark sheet in the Examination Branch of concerned campus within fifteen (15) days.

Q.2- What are the charges for revaluation and where is it deposited in University of Delhi?

Ans-The Prescribed Fee for revaluation is Rs.1,000/- per paper to be deposited with the University Cashier between 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. on all working days after verification of the form at the Revaluation Cell Counter. (Window No. 1)

***Fee is subject to change.**

Q.3- Is Revaluation allowed in all courses in University of Delhi?

Ans- Revaluation is allowed only in theory papers of non-professional courses, which have not been jointly evaluated.

Q.4- What happens if a student does not want any change in marks after revaluation in University of Delhi?

Ans-Students have to surrender their original performance when they apply for revaluation and shall have to accept the revised performance in which: -

- a) There can be NO CHANGE in the marks.
- b) There can be INCREASE in the marks.
- c) There can be DECREASE in the marks.

Q.5-When can the student apply for Revaluation or Re-checking in University of Delhi?

Ans- Revaluation and Re-checking is to be applied within 15 days of the date of uploading of results on the website of University of Delhi i.e. www.du.ac.in
