

## **Procedure to obtain Evaluated Answer Script**

### **Q.1-Can students obtain a copy of evaluated answer script in University of Delhi?**

Ans- Yes, if any student is not satisfied with marks he/ she scored, then they may get copy of evaluated answer script from the University of Delhi after completing all formalities.

### **Q.2- When can a student apply for evaluated answer script in University of Delhi?**

Ans-An application should be submitted within 61st and 75<sup>th</sup> day of declaration of result on the website of University of Delhi.

### **Q.3- What are the required documents for submitting an application for the evaluated answer script in University of Delhi?**

Ans- The candidate is required to produce his/her current admission ticket and/or statements of marks for verification of roll no., mark etc., at the time of submission of application form.

### **Q.4- What is the prescribed fee criteria for evaluated answer script in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The prescribed fee for the evaluation of answer scripts amounts to Rs.750/-.

### **Q.5- Where can students obtain the form for evaluated answer script in University of Delhi?**

Ans. - Students can obtain the form for evaluation of answer scripts from the website of University of Delhi i.e. [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in) .

### **Q.6- When can students obtain their copy of the evaluated answer scripts in University of Delhi?**

Ans. - Students can obtain their copy of the evaluated answer scripts within thirty days of submission of the application. The student is required to collect the copy of the evaluated script within a period of fifteen days of the date of intimation of availability of the script on the website of University of Delhi i.e. [www.du.ac.in](http://www.du.ac.in)
