

## **SPORTS COUNCIL**

### **Q.1. Where is the University Sports Complex located?**

Ans. The University Sports Complex is located in the North campus of University of Delhi adjacent to Faculty of Education.

### **Q.2. What is the objective of the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The Sports establishment accomplishes the objectives and its educational role in promoting Activity Oriented Education with various theoretical and desirable aspects of co-ordination, monitoring, supervision and control mainly through a statutory body of the University known as University of Delhi Sports Council.

### **Q.3. What is the main purpose of the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The main purpose of the Sports Council in University of Delhi is to initiate, coordinate, execute and manage various kinds of Sports Activities including Adventure Sports and other such sports to promote general interest in Games and Sports in the University and to improve the standard of Competitive Sports and Games in the University and also its affiliated colleges / institutions.

### **Q.4. Where can one contact if one has to become a member of Fitness Centre of Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The students who want to become a member of Fitness Centre of Sports council shall have to contact to the Sports Council, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007, Phone: 27667104, 27667725 Univ. Ext:1645, 1647 & 1648.

### **Q.5. Is there any faculty available in the Sports Council in the University of Delhi?**

Ans. University of Delhi has highly qualified and experienced University appointed teachers of Physical Education, designated as Director in Professor's scale and two Dy. Director(s) in Reader scale along with a Coach to plan coordinate and execute the functioning of Physical Education and Sports Setup in the University, at various levels of Co-ordination and co-operation.

### **Q.6. Who is eligible for the membership of the Fitness Centre of Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Bona-fide Post-graduate level students of the University of Delhi are eligible for the membership of Fitness Centre of Sports Council in University of Delhi.

### **Q.7. Does Sports council has its own Fitness Centre?**

Ans. Yes, Sports council has its own fitness Centre.

### **Q.8. Does Sports council has its own badminton court?**

Ans. Yes, Sports council has its own badminton court.

### **Q.9. How can one become a member of the Fitness Centre?**

Ans. A person who is interested to be a member of the Fitness Centre is required to submit registration form along with two passport size photographs.

### **Q.10. Is there any fee charges for the membership of the Sports Council?**

Ans. Yes, the fee shall be charged by the Sports Council according to the norms of the University of Delhi.

**Q.11. Is the fee refundable by the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. No, there is no provision for fee refund in any circumstances by the Sports Council.

**Q.12. Is there any provision of classes in the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Yes, there is provision of classes in the Sports Council in University of Delhi

**Q.13. Are classes compulsory for all members of the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Yes, classes are compulsory for all members of the Sports Council in University of Delhi. Classes missed on account of any reason shall not be adjusted.

**Q.14. Is the membership of the Sports Council transferable in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The membership of the Sports Council is personal to a member and cannot be assigned, transferred or disposed of.

**Q.15. Is the medical examination mandatory for all members in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Members are advised to undergo a medical examination prior to joining and using the Fitness Centre / Badminton Court.

**Q.16. Is there any particular system for entry or exit in the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Yes, entry shall be allowed by the identity card only, which is provided by the Sports Council in University of Delhi.

**Q.17. What is the provision of obtaining the duplicate Identity card if somebody loses his/her Identity card?**

Ans. One has to lodge an F.I.R if he/ she lose his/her identity card and submit a copy of the F.I.R with Rs.50/- in the Fitness Centre's office. The office shall issue a duplicate identity card.

**Q. 18. Is there any attendance marking system in the Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. Yes, there is attendance marking system in the Sports Council in University of Delhi. The membership of those students shall be automatically cancelled who are found irregular i.e. absent for four consecutive days.

**Q.19. What is the admission process for Sports Council in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The admission or enrollment for Sports Council in University of Delhi shall be based on first come first serve.

**Q.20. What is the responsibility of Sports council in sports based admission in the University of Delhi?**

Ans. Yes, the Sports council is involved in all sports activities conducted by college as well as in the sports based admission.

**Q.21. Define the role of the Sports Council in the Sports quota admission in the University of Delhi?**

Ans. Sports Council is responsible to handover a list of the short listed students to all colleges after completing all sports trials. Then admission shall be finalized for the sports quota.

**Q.22. Is there any provision of Sports kit by the Fitness Centre?**

Ans. Sports kit is not provided by the Fitness Centre.

**Q.23. What are the equipment included in the Sports kit?**

Ans.: The equipment included in the Sports kit are as follows:

- (a) Towel
- (b) Track Suit
- (c) Shoes
- (d) Water Bottle
