### **Q.1.What is the objective of University Information Centre (UIC) in University of Delhi?**

Ans. University Information Centre (UIC) is an interface between the University of Delhi and its stakeholders notably the students and their parents. The main objective of University Information Centre (UIC) is to deliver effective and efficient information services to the students of University of Delhi regarding admissions, examinations and other information related to their academic pursuits.

### **Q.2 What are the activities of University Information Centre (UIC) in University of Delhi?**

Ans. The Information Executives at University Information Centre (UIC) with dedicated phone lines, e-mail and internet services disseminate student related information on all working days of University of Delhi. University Information Centre (UIC) facilitates following information to serve the needs of students of University of Delhi at different stages of their academic pursuits:

- Information related to admissions for undergraduate, post graduate, professional and research programmes in University of Delhi and its constituent colleges.
- Procedure for admission to various hostels of the University of Delhi and its constituent colleges.
- Information regarding teaching-learning programmes in the University of Delhi and its constituent colleges.
- Post-examination information services such as procedures for the issue of duplicate mark-sheets, degrees, Inter University migration, Transcripts, Degree verification form, certificates and other testimonials, etc.

### **Q.3 What are the information services provided by University Information Centre (UIC) related to student support systems?**

Ans. The information services related to student support system provided by University Information Centre (UIC):

- Fee Concession and student Aid Fund
- Scholarships, Fellowships etc.
- Special grants for research work
- International student exchange programmes
- Information for students coming from outside Delhi/India
- Information related to Foreign Students
- Information regarding equivalence of International Schools/Boards
- Information regarding cultural and extra- curricular activities, sports, NSS, NCC etc.
- Facilities for the differently-abled students (Physically Handicapped)
- Students Union elections both at the University and at the colleges
- Medical Facilities.

Ans. The other information services provided by University Information Centre (UIC) are as follows:

- Information Services relating to University of Delhi Library System and its various sub systems.
- Information related to Alumni of University of Delhi.

- Information services relating to Adult Education Programmes of the University of Delhi.
- Information regarding short duration courses (Certificate courses), Diploma courses, Advanced Diploma courses, Add-on courses, etc. of the University of Delhi.
- Information services relating to redressal of grievances of students.
- Information services relating to Gandhi Bhawan, University Popular Lecture Series, Conferences, Workshops, etc.
