

PROCESS/PROCEDURE OF EXAMINATIONS

Undergraduate Examination

Q.1.-When can students fill their examination form in the University of Delhi?

Ans- The examination form for all undergraduate regular students can be filled up till the date notified by the University of Delhi.

Q.2-What is the fee of examination in University of Delhi?

Ans- The minimum charges is Rs.100-/per paper which may be revised as per the University rules. This charge may be different from course to course also.

***Fee is subject to change.**

Q.3- Where can students see their examination result in University of Delhi?

Ans- The students can see their examination result on the official website of University of Delhi i.e. www.du.ac.in.

Q.4-What are the criteria of promotion from one class to another class under semester system in University of Delhi?

Ans- A student shall be eligible for promotion from first year to second year of the course in University of Delhi provided he / she has passed 50% of the papers of first and second semester taken together.

Q.5- What is the procedure if a student wants to reappear in any semester in University of Delhi?

Ans- A student who has to reappear in a course prescribed for semester Ist/IIIrd/Vth may do so only in the semester examination to be held in November/ December. A student who has to reappear in a course prescribed for semester IInd/IVth/VIth may do so only in the semester examination to be held in April/May every year.

Q.6-Can students reappear in Practical/Internal Assessment in University of Delhi?

Ans- No, Reappearance in Practical / Internal Assessment shall not be allowed in University of Delhi.

Q.7- What shall happen if a student reappears for theory paper as an ex-student in University of Delhi?

Ans- A student who reappears for theory paper as an ex-student shall carry forward the internal assessment marks, originally awarded.

Q.8- What are the components of Internal Assessment in University of Delhi till academic session 2012-13?

Ans- The components of Internal Assessment in University of Delhi till academic session 2012-13 is as follows:

- Class Test/ Presentation etc. 10%
- Assignments, Workshops etc. 10%
- Attendance and Tutorials. 5%

Q.9 -What is the procedure, if a student has already passed Part 3rd and wants to reappear in the same for improvement purpose?

Ans- A student who has already cleared the paper of Part 3rd (5th and 6th semester) may reappear in any course of 5th and 6th semester only once, at the immediate subsequent examination on foregoing in writing her/his previous performance in the concerned paper, within the prescribed span period.

Q.10-Can a student eligible to take admission in Post-graduation in case he/she wants to reappear in 3rd Year?

Ans-No, a student who is willing to reappear in 3rd year after passing, shall not be allowed to join any post graduate course in University of Delhi.

Q.11- What shall happen if a candidate applies for reappearing but not able to appear for the examination in University of Delhi?

Ans- The previous marks shall remain but they should inform the Examination Branch, University of Delhi in this regard.

Q.12- What is the division criteria in University of Delhi till academic session 2012-13?

Ans- A student who passes all the papers prescribed for semester 1st to semester 6th examination would be eligible for the degree. Such a student shall be categorized on the basis of the combined result of semester 1st to semester 6th examination and also for annual scheme.

Q.13-What is the percentage required for passing in any course under semester system in University of Delhi?

Ans-The minimum marks required to pass in any course in a semester shall be 40% in theory and clubbing both theory and Internal Assessment aggregate, wherever applicable.
